## **2010 “BBQ DESSERT” RULES FOR CONTESTANTS**

Contestants in UP Hog Wild 2010 who wish to participate in the 2010 “BBQ DESSERT COMPETITION” must follow these guidelines. These rules have been established by UP Hog Wild, Inc. This is not a KCBS sanctioned portion of our competition. IT IS BEING JUDGED BY KCBS JUDGES.

1. Any Registered team who has signed up for this event will be able to participate. You must pre-register.
2. There will be a \$15.00 entry fee to compete in the UP Hog Wild 2010 “BBQ DESSERT COMPETITION”.
3. Dessert Entries must be prepared on the UP Hog Wild 2010 grounds.
4. Dessert Entries must be prepared on a smoker or grill. This is a BBQ dessert contest.
5. Presentation or appearance, Taste, and Creativity will all be factors in the judging.
6. After the cooks meeting, each team competing will be provided with a numbered container.
7. 2:00 PM on Saturday July 17<sup>th</sup> is the posted turn in time. This is thirty minutes after the last KCBS category.
8. Entries will be accepted five (5) minutes prior to, through five (5) minutes after the posted turn in time.
9. Competing teams will be asked to deliver their prepared “BBQ Dessert Competition” entry in the numbered container to the designated drop off table at the judge’s tent.
10. You may choose to use your own serving piece for your entry. It must be accompanied by your numbered container. UP Hog Wild is not responsible for returning your serving piece. Please be prompt in picking it up from the judge’s tent after the event.
11. Only contest organizers will know the identity of each team’s entry. Contest organizers will renumber the entries. The individuals selected to judge this competition will only know the entry they taste by the NEW number located on the entry container.
12. Judges will be chosen from the same judges used for the KCBS categories.
13. Each judge will be given a “Ballot”. They will be asked to judge your entry based on three general categories. 1) Appearance (weighted .5714), 2) Taste (weighted 2.2858), and 3) General Creativity (weighted 1.1428). Each category will be judged using a number from 1 to 9. One (1) being lowest and Nine (9) being highest. Weighted multipliers will be used to determine a total score.
14. The wining teams will be determined based upon a tabulation of all valid ballots.
15. Prizes will be awarded for first, second and third place.
16. Winners will be announced during the awards presentation on Saturday afternoon.
